

## TRAVEL AND SAFETY ADVICE

### NORTHERN IRELAND V GERMANY

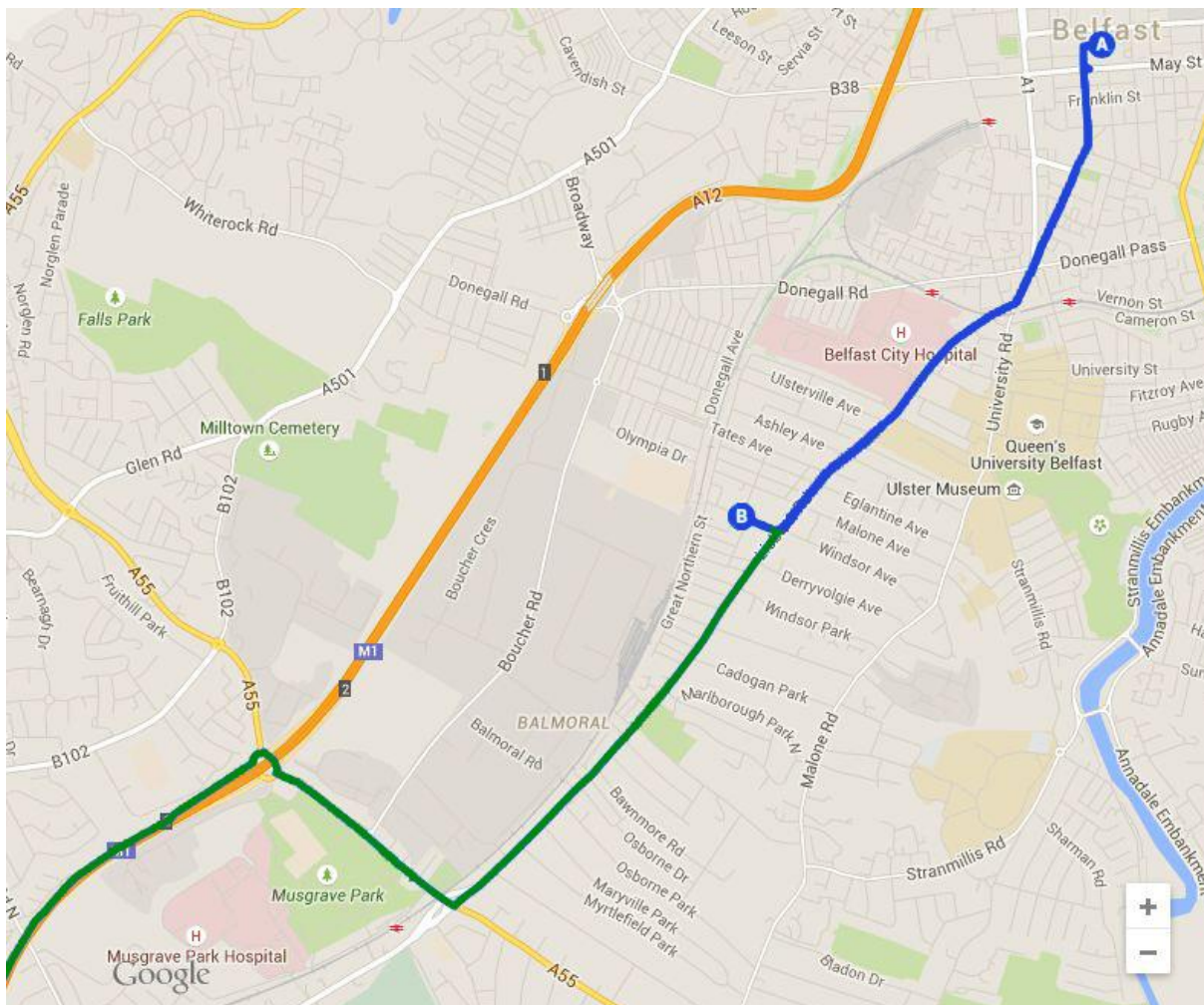
The FIFA World Cup Qualifying match between Northern Ireland and Germany will take place at the National Stadium, Windsor Park, Belfast on Thursday 5 October 2017 at 7.45pm.

All supporters should plan their journey well in advance to ensure they arrive at the stadium early to avoid congestion. Entry to the game is by ticket only and you will not be allowed access to the game without a valid ticket.

The advised routes for German supporters coming to the game are as follows:

Belfast City centre – Shaftesbury Square – Lisburn Road – Lower Windsor Avenue – Railway footbridge – Sectors I, J, T and K in the North Stand or VIP area in South Stand.

M1 Motorway from Dublin – exit at Stockman’s Lane (A55) – Lisburn Road – Lower Windsor Avenue – Railway footbridge – Sectors I,J,T, K in the North Stand or VIP area in South Stand.



Those supporters arriving by coach should be dropped off pre-match and picked up after match at Lisburn Road / Lower Windsor Avenue. Drivers will be advised of parking arrangements.

Fans meeting in the city centre are advised there are pubs and hot food outlets in the Dublin Road / Great Victoria Street area and Shaftesbury Square / Bradbury Place en route to the stadium.

The laws in relation to drinking in public places and the carrying of alcohol on supporters' buses may be different in Northern Ireland than in Germany. Signs are displayed in public places where the drinking of alcohol is forbidden.

Alcohol will be on sale in the stadium.

### **IT IS A CRIMINAL OFFENCE**

- To enter or attempt to enter the stadium if you are in possession of any pyrotechnic device including fireworks, flares, Bengal lights etc
- To throw any articles capable of causing injury
- To engage in any racist, sectarian or homophobic chanting
- To go on to the playing area
- To be in possession of alcohol on a coach going to this event

### **NOTE**

- Fans who have consumed excess alcohol may not be permitted to enter the stadium.
- German Football Federation to nominate collection point for tickets
